- **9:26am** *Standardized database of police-reported crashes in multiple states* – Eric Teoh, Director of Statistical Services, IIHS Highway Loss Data Institute.
Presentation from 2023 Traffic Records Forum in Nashville.
9:37am Question about new data with new vehicles (e.g., scooters). How are they being standardized? It will vary. Second question about approximately 35 state crash reports, has IIHS looked at questions at the local level? Coded relatively.

Traffic Records National Region 5 shows Illinois not on electronic data transfer- grants available to assist (FARS). MMUCC 6 being finalized. 12/27/23 ready to go live. Free training for law enforcement officers. Most important is data quality and then checking data integration. Kaci will meet with Sarah Moore. Jessica Keldermans added looking to update crash reports- will also talk to Mark Blankenship. MMUCC will be ready Aug./Sept. of next year? So it's being ready at end of this year first? Kaci- will go into review in December or finalize in December.

- **9:41am** Comments from FHWA – Alan Ho
New component of VRU and working with Mickey for VRU information.
- **9:55am** Comments from FMCSA – Christine Kobos/Christopher Luebbert
New MCSAP Coordinator is Julie Kaschke. Kaci- NHTSA for 6 years. State not involved in truck apps but wants to get Illinois in forefront (e.g., more involvement). Missouri is pushing HSP, HSIP, SHSP all from the same office. Crashes of non-CV driver typically leading causation. Christine Kobos [FMCSA], State Program Specialist, the “new Greg Piland” just started last week. SSDQ=State Safety Data Quality measures. Increase timeliness of crashes because indicators of likely future crashes. Anyone to call for help? Jessica Keldermans- once entered, auto sent to IDOT Bureau of Investigations for Safety Net. Was Nikki Quinn, now in Data Collection. Also has DC staff helping with Safety Net and FARS (started Jul. 1). 94% of crash reports are electronic.
- **10:23am** Roadway Update – Bill Morgan
Urban area census and East St. Louis. Urban areas have deadline for FHWA, after approved, 1.5 more to get done. New FHWA coding guide- working with Bureau of Bridges and Structures.
- **10:25am** Crash Update – Jessica Keldermans
Crash data collection SR1050 good for 01/01/2026. Suggestions for possible updates. Explain MMUCC. 2019 crash report used 5th edition MMUCC. Does take preparation and meet internally with DC, BSPE, and Bill Morgan- draft changes. ISP, CDOT, ILSOS, IDONR, and CPD. For 2025, put out RFP for crash report paper printer stuff, have form printed and sent to police departments. Will be ready approximately October 2025 and use 01/01/2025. Third party vendor with CIS with coding for electronic vendors. Steve submitted CR info from Parry. Gender X, with ILSOS and ISP, IDOT cannot use because X and U considered UNK; using O for other. FBI also cannot use X. Citations use X but will convert to O, don't want to transfer other X's to O's. Hoping January 2024. CIS RFP back with Office of Chief Counsel. Parry Frank- electronic cross-reference for people with vehicle with wrong lat/longs. Parry will email Jessica. AOIC had deadline so IDOT determined internally and met with ISP, going forward from there.

**down for eleven days- security breach. Several States Affected.
