### AGENDA

#### Call to Order and Introductions

Chairperson Nancy Easum called the meeting to order. Each attendee introduced themselves, including those joining online.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

Nancy explained that the minutes from the November meeting were not completed prior to this meeting and will be reviewed for approval next month.

#### Welcome State's Attorney Patrick Kenneally

Nancy welcomed State's Attorney Patrick Kenneally, who is a voting member of the Task Force representing the Illinois State's Attorney's Association.

#### **Discussion of Legislative Proposals**

Ms. Easum moderated discussion regarding various legislative proposals the Task Force has been considering in recent months.

- Mr. Kenneally began with an overview of his proposal to prohibit accused DUI offenders from refusing chemical testing, supporting no-refusal actions in DUI cases. The group asked questions and provided suggestions for improvement.

- Discussion then turned to another proposal by State's Attorney Kenneally involving propository evidence in DUI cases. After deliberation, the group decided to table this proposal for further consideration at the next month's meeting.

- Mr. Kenneally presented his third proposal that would alter Illinois law to include any felony DUI offense as detainable offenses. The group discussed and unanimously agreed that this proposal would be a reasonable and helpful law change.

- Mr. Kenneally also discussed his proposal to return Illinois to a zero-tolerance THC per se level. Sabra Jones provided insight into the science and toxicology behind detecting THC in a person's body and its correlation to impairment. The Task Force agreed to reconsider this proposal along with others in the future.

#### Discussion on Paragraph a(7) of 625 ILCS 11-501

Limited discussion took place regarding this paragraph, and notes from previous discussions will be shared with the group for review.

# Overview of Felony DUI Offenders Eligible for "Time-Served" Credit on Home Confinement

Erin Payton and Christine Vukmir gave an overview of this issue, highlighting its impact on DUI offenders and victims. Discussion also occurred regarding the driver license compact and the lack of membership by neighboring states.

#### Legislative Proposal Compilation

ASA Vukmir will compile a legislative proposal to address various issues discussed at the meeting, including the exchange of driving records and purging DUI records.

#### **Other Business**

- Ms. Sanders of the Illinois Liquor Control Commission addressed the issue of individuals buying alcohol in convenience stores and consuming it in gambling spaces. Local individuals were encouraged to reach out to discuss further.

- Nancy Easum requested input on focus areas, and members from each area gave reports.

#### Next Meeting

The next meeting will be held on March 1st in the Chicago area, with a virtual option available.

#### Adjournment
