Safety Tips





- O Drop it and drive.
- O Slow down and obey speed limits.
- O If possible, move over for workers.
- O Pay attention. Conditions can change quickly.
- O Give heavy vehicles room to adjust to conditions.
- O Remember: Traffic backups can occur at any time.

Merging Safely

▶ If lanes are reduced due to road work and

- O the road is **not heavily congested**, merge early into the open lane.
- O there is **heavy congestion or slow** traffic, use either lane up to the reduction, then take turns merging.
